


Web EHSdesk™ provides a fully integrated suite of web-based software modules designed to support administrative, operational, and business process information management associated with Environment, Health, and Safety (EHS).

The PPE Assessment module allows the assessor to document machine-specific personal protective equipment (PPE) assessments and outline the protective gear required for each part of the body when operating a piece of equipment. PPE Assessment uses a checklist that helps the assessor determine what hazards exist and what protective gear is necessary. Once the assessment is complete, this information can be printed in the form of the "PPE Dude" Report and may be posted at the equipment and used as an operator reference. PPE Assessment can be used as a standalone module or as part of the Safety suite.

Features and Functionality

- Multiple assessments may be performed per Equipment Id
- Simple questionnaire to help determine if protective gear is required by body area
- PPE Dude report identifies specific PPE with comments, as well as general comments not tied to a specific body area PPE




PPE Assessment Summary Page

Benefits

- Posting report enables personnel to safely operate machinery per the visual posting report, serving as a safety reference tool

Integration Points

 EHSdesk Corrective Action Request (CAR): a CAR can be created during the assessment to track missing or deficient PPE
